

1. The administrator of your personal data is MOTO-KOM Sp. z o.o. (hereinafter MOTO-KOM) with its registered office and address in Płock, ul. Wyszogrodzka 84B, e-mail motokom@wp.pl
2. Your personal data regarding your name, address, social security number, contact number, email address, driving licence data has been obtained from you.
3. Your personal data will be processed:
 - a) in order to implement the Agreement entrusting the vehicle for test ride under the conditions set out in the Agreement - in accordance with Article 6(1)(b) GDPR - the provision of personal data by you is voluntary, but is a condition for the conclusion and proper performance of the contract (the consequence of failure to provide personal data will be the inability to provide services under the Agreement)
 - b) to comply with moto-kom's legal obligations;
 - c) to pursue legitimate interests pursued by MOTO-KOM;
 - d) in the case of giving separate consent, for the purpose of marketing and promoting products and services of entities providing services related to MOTO-KOM products and services by electronic and telephone means;
 - e) in the case of separate consent, the transfer of personal data to MOTO-KOM and their processing by that entity for the purpose of marketing the products and services of that entity by electronic and telephone.
4. The recipient of your personal data will be employees and associates of MOTO-KOM and other entities to whom personal data will be transferred based on your instructions or entrusted with the processing of your personal data.
5. You can obtain a copy of the personal data processed by MOTO-KOM.
6. Your personal data will be stored for the period of performance of the Agreement, no longer than until the expiry of the mandatory period of their storage resulting from the law, as regards limitation periods and archiving. For the purposes referred to in point 3(c)(e), the data will be processed until the promotional and marketing activities are completed or consent is withdrawn.
7. You have the right to access your personal data, the right to request the rectification, erasure or restriction of the processing of such data, the right to data portability;
8. You have the right to object to the processing referred to in point 3(c)(e), in the case referred to in point 3(c) it must be related to your individual situation.
9. You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time, but this will not affect the lawfulness of processing based on your consent
