During our trip, we will admire many of the huge number of two- and three-thousand-meter peaks, but also amazing, green, wildlife, wonderfully situated lakes and rivers. The fresh mountain air can make you dizzy! There are also many charming towns on the foothills of the Pyrenees and some of them are included on our route. We begin and end our trip in the Spanish city of Girona boasting one of the best-preserved medieval old towns in Spain and the oldest Jewish district in Europe.

# FUN FACTS

- The name of the country, España, is derived from the word “Ispania” which means “Land of the Rabbits.”
- Spanish language is one of the 5 top most spoken languages in the world.
- The Spaniards brought potatoes, tobacco, tomatoes, cocoa, corn and many more products to Europe.
- Spain is the biggest producer of olive oil in the whole world and produces on average about 44% of the world’s supply of olive oil each year.
- Madrid boasts an average of more than 300 days of sunshine per year.
- Spanish is the official language in 23 countries in the world.
- In general, a person born into a Spanish-speaking family is given a first name followed by two surnames, the first being the father’s family name and the second being the mother’s family name.
- In Spain, people greet each other and say goodbye with a kiss on each cheek. They usually touch their right cheeks together and make a kissing sound, then repeat the process on the left side.
- You can hear a whistled language in The Canary Islands! In 2009, the language was included in the UNESCO list.
